2 Cor. 4:1; 1 Peter 2:9-12; Titus 3:4-8; Eph. 2:4-5

Theology of Romans chapters 1 thru 11

- The righteousness of God is being revealed 1:16-17
 - God’s activity of making Right-Saving-Vindicating satisfying His justice and the status of those who are made Right-that is being revealed-brought to light in the book of Romans.
2 Cor. 5:17-19

I. Righteousness needed 1:18-3:20

II. Righteousness Imputed 3:21-5:21

III. Righteousness Imparted chapter 6-8

IV. Righteousness rejected chapter 9-11

Therefore Because of God’s mercy in view... What’s your response?
Romans 12:1-2

- I urge you brothers and sisters to present to God.
- Your body, your mind, your will.

1) The body must be given to God vs. 1b

Matt. 6:23-33; Phil. 1:20

- Our humanness, yielded continually to God
Romans 6:12-13, 18-19; 7:22-23; 8:11-13, 23; 1 Cor. 6:19-20
- As a living and holy sacrifice
Hebrews 9:11-12; 11:4; 13:15-16; Col. 3:1-10
- This is acceptable to God
2 Cor. 5:9; Eph. 5:10
- Which is your spiritual service of worship
Heb. 9:6; Phil. 1:19-21; 2:17

2) The mind must be given to God vs. 2a

Eph. 4:23; Col. 3:10; Psalm 119:160, 169-176

- Do not be conformed to the world
1 Peter 1:14-15; 1 John 2:15-17; 5:19; Eph. 4:17-20
- But be transformed
Matt. 17:2; 2 Cor. 5:17; Titus 3:5; 2 Cor. 3:18
- By the renewing of your mind
Col. 3:9-10, 16; 2 Peter 2:20; Eph. 4:22-24; Gal. 5:16-17

3) The will must be given to God vs. 2b

1 Peter 4:2; Col. 1:9; Mark 3:35; Matt. 26:36-39

- So that you may prove/approve God's will:
Col. 1:9-12; Eph. 5:10, 17; Psalm 34:8
- That which is good and acceptable and perfect
Romans 7:12, 22; Psalm 143:10; Eph. 2:10; Proverbs 3:1-4
