- 8) Be devoted to prayer
- 9) Contributing to the needs of the saints
- 10) Practicing hospitality

III. Our duty to all people vs. 14-21

- 1) Bless those who persecute you
- 2) Rejoice with those who rejoice
- 3) Weep with those who weep
- 4) Do not be partial
- 5) Avoid haughtiness
- 6) Associate with the lowly
- 7) Do not view yourself better than others

- 8) Never return evil for evil
- 9) Always respect what is right
- 10) Live in peace with everyone
- 11) Never average yourself
- 12) Overcome evil with good
