Questions:

- 1. If the Gospels record the call and commissioning of the disciples, and Acts records the preaching of the disciples, then which epistles record how to make disciples in the local churches?
- 2. What other names do the epistles use for the disciples?
- 3. What does the content of every New Testament epistle have in common?

Conclusion: The Gospel (evangelism) isn't only for justification; It's also essential to sanctification.

Point B: One way God has given us to keep the Gospel central in our discipleship and remind us that we are in the family of God is through his command to evangelize children.

John 8:31 Jesus said, "If you abide in my Word then you are truly my disciples."

John 14:15 Jesus said, "If you love me, keep my commandments."

Questions:

- 1. What is the Greatest Commandment and where did Jesus get his answer to that question?
- 2. How does "The Shema" teach us to love God by keeping his commandments on our hearts?
- 3. Is the evangelism and discipleship of children mainly a female responsibility?
