Intro: Chapter 1

Comfort in persecution and affliction

- persecutions—to pursue with repeated acts of enmity.
- Afflictions—to crush—press or squeeze - cause distress—cause tribulations
  
- Commending them in their walk with Christ vs. 3-5
  - In the face of persecutions:
    - + You have flourishing faith
    - + You have growing love
    - + You have persevering hope
    - + You have a kingdom attitude
