- **Who is Jesus?** He is the _____ and the source of _____ to all who repent and believe in Him (v. 10-14)

- **What is Her Problem?** She thinks her problem is that she is rejected by people. Her real problem is that she is spiritually _____. Without water you will die. Jesus offers her _____ water (v. 10)
- **What is the Solution? What must she do?** She must be given new life by _____ in Jesus. (v. 21) She must worship in _____ and in _____ (v. 23). In other words, to be born-again by the Spirit, (i.e., to be made alive by living water), and to repent of her ignorant idolatry by receiving the Light and worshipping according to God’s truth.
- **What does submission to the Savior by faith look like?** She believes in Jesus as the Messiah and worships him by spreading the good news about Jesus by _____ and _____ (v. 28)

Jesus models submission to God for us. (v. 34)

He provides us motivation to evangelize and an explanation as to why we witness (v. 35-38)

Our testimony brings people to Jesus, but they must believe in his self-revelation (v. 39-42)

Jesus provides signs to authenticate his identity, his message, and his promise of eternal life (v. 46-54)

Obstacle to Evangelism #2: We don't love our neighbors as we should because we fear rejection & ridicule. Worship is an act of faith. Evangelism is an act of worship.
