 - IV. Exalt Jesus Christ as Lord vs. 9-11

 - V. Pursue and embrace God’s sanctifying work in your lives vs. 12-13

: without grumbling or disputing vs. 14b
 - Grumbling—is essentially emotional
 - Carries the idea of complaining
 - Disputing—is essentially intellectual
 - Carries the idea of questioning, doubting or Disputing God’s truth of the matter
- So that: you should be becoming innocent, blameless, above reproach children of God vs. 15a
